Preface

The Holy Spirit is **Calling us to Pray**; to immerse ourselves in a deeper union and Love with Jesus through the complete passions and Life of Jesus; who sends the Holy Spirit upon us to open our hearts so we may listen to the Holy Spirit through the word of God and be led by the Holy Spirit through **The Life and Passions of Jesus**, as we offer up our prayers for the Glory of God, and the salvation of souls.

My hope and prayer is that **The Life and Passions of Jesus Prayer**, the Christian version of the rosary will help you go into a deep meditative prayer, walking with Jesus, from conception to Resurrection, the Life and Passions of Jesus. Opening your mind up to interact with the living word of God, so you can travel from the mind to the heart where you will find Jesus waiting for you. He loves you so much and calls you to come home! There is no wrong way to pray if it is from the heart, for **Love** is perfect, it bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things, **Love** never Fails! (1 Corinthians 13:7-8). So, I hope that when you read and pray about the Life and Passions of Jesus you will realize that it is for all people who **Love** Jesus. That you will see all the Meditations and Prayers on **The Life and Passions of Jesus** comes from scripture in the Bible, along with the perfect prayer from Jesus, (Matthew 6:9-13) The Our Father Prayer, along with the O my Jesus prayer; that is made up from scripture passages to praise God in prayer. So, Pray, and give to God what is God's, **"Yourself"!** **Peter the Apostle said it right, "Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy one from God"!** (John 6:68-69)

Let me share a brief history on my walk of faith. My life before the age of 38 was only lived in the flesh, seeking all the world could offer to fill this void in me. This drove me to the extremes of seeking fulfillment and happiness through lust, sexuality, money, success, material possessions and the final vice to fill this void was drugs; which left me homeless and addicted to drugs. So, no matter what the world or flesh would offer to fill this void within my soul, it would never be enough, leaving me even emptier; knowing deep within myself there must be more to our lives than what the world can offer. The answer to this call that comes from within is The Gift of Love, the Holy Spirit dispensed through grace; puts us on the path of light, seeking truth, righteousness, and the call to be a servant to all. Hence, filling that void in us; to love God and our brothers and sisters as our self. Nothing on Earth can fill that void in our souls, only grace, the gift of love from God!

My spiritual journey to answer this call from within began with my first experience with spirituality when I became a Catholic at 25 years old, but for all the wrong reasons at the time. My wife was Catholic and wanted to get our marriage blessed in the church. To me it was just another wedding celebration, we were already married. Her family knew a priest who allowed me to join the formation class that was just finishing up, preparing to come into the Catholic faith on Easter.

Being Catholic to me was just a name. If someone asked what Faith I was, I could say Roman Catholic. But I will say, it did plant a seed. I had numerous encounters with God as I felt his call and influence leading me during my life from age 25 to 38, when major cross roads came up in my life. The day that I died to myself and said yes to the will of God to walk in my faith, started during my conversion in 1997 at a weekend Cursillo encounter, at St. Ambrose Catholic Church in Tucson, AZ. The Holy Spirit tore down my walls of self-love, pride, fear and exposed my heart to the beating of the Eucharistic heart of Jesus. Truly these words are true, when the Holy Spirit touches your heart; the truth shall set you free! This was the turning point in my life when I truly came home to the love of God which filled that huge void in my life.

The soul that truly loves God does not resign itself to waiting for heaven in order to be united to Him, we can have Heaven on Earth. This is a gift from God the grace that comes forth through his beloved Son, the

Holy Spirit that will lead us and sustain us as we call out and proclaim our “yes” speak Lord for your servant is listening; to seek and do your will. Only thru God can we have a taste of Heaven on Earth; God wants to give you this gift of grace. Is it possible? Yes, Jesus has said: “If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him; and we will come to him and will make our abode with him”. Our Lord himself tells us in these words the condition for living united to him: Love. “He that abideth in charity abideth in God and God in him.” Love is the great power which unites us to God even in this life. “Heaven on Earth”

Let me share with you one last thing that has happened recently on the completion of the book cover, **The Day the World Changed, The Call to Pray**; which use to be **The Life and Passions of Jesus**. Which came to be during my visit with my in-laws in Florida for the New Year's Holiday, when I was in prayer on New Years Day 01-01-09 the new book cover, **The Day the World Changed, The Call to Pray** was revealed to me; through a scripture passage. (John 1: 23) “I am a voice of one crying out in the desert **The Call to Pray**; make straight the way of the Lord.” That moment I knew this was the new book cover and the completion of the book from The Holy Spirit. Have you ever just felt I Know? Because I know, you can feel this truth unveiled to the deepest parts of your soul. It is so powerful and awesome, you can't truly describe this feeling with words alone, and you only can truly understand this experience within yourself; becoming Christ conscious. For the word of God is living and effective, sharper than any two-edged sword, penetrating even between soul and spirit, joints and marrow, and able to discern reflections and thoughts of the heart (Hebrews 4:12-13)

The fascinating part about this is the fact that The Holy Spirit put into my heart the prayer; **The Life and Passions of Jesus** back in 9/11/01. Did you notice the completion of the book and cover came on 1-1-09, which is 911 backwards, and now we are coming upon the 8-year anniversary of 9-11-09 which is also 911 forwards and backwards. Another date that comes up is 9/11/19 which is also 911 forward and backwards, fascinating how all these dates over the years seem to come together. We had a dedication and memorial services on 9/11/09 at Holy Family Catholic Church in Tucson AZ. Donating an 8' statue of **Our Lady of Life, The Call to Pray** for the Gift of Life and the Salvation of Souls, in memory of and dedicated to all the souls and survivors of the 9/11/01 tragedy.

Another date that has come up in prayer is 9/11/11 which is 9/11 the day and 9/11 the year! Based on the flesh and human standards these are the numbers that represent the need for urgent response (emergency). The call to pray, this date was our 10-year anniversary. With that being said I didn't know why or what these dates may bring forth, and I may never know, and that's ok, for I am just a messenger passing along **The Call to Pray** and the word of God!

For this reason I kneel before the Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth is named, that he may grant you in accord with the riches of his glory to be strengthened with power through his spirit in the inner self; and that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, rooted and grounded in love, may have strength to comprehend with all the holy ones what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, so that you may be filled with all the fullness of God. (Ephesians 3: 14-19) So are the dates I mentioned a Coincidence or God Coincidence, you decide.

The History behind the Life and Passions of Jesus Prayer The Call to Pray

The history behind **The Call to Pray**, **The Life and Passions of Jesus Prayer**, starts back on 9-11-01 when the most tragic attack on the Twin Towers in New York occurred, which resulted in much loss of life and tragedy to follow. On this day I was in California away from my home in Arizona. All flights were cancelled, so I had no way to get home. Wishing to get home to my family, I drove through the night praying the Rosary over and over going through the Passions of Christ. Then all of a sudden I felt inspired by the spirit within me to pray the complete Passions of Christ, but as one consecutive Prayer, saying all (3) mysteries with (3) Hail Mary's between each mystery.

So I started thinking, where could I get Rosary Beads and the things to make this new Rosary? As I arrived in Tucson, AZ. early the next morning, after the 9/11 tragedy I decided to ignore my inner thoughts to make the Rosary. Just as I was thinking of this my phone rang with a job request for data and phone lines to be added in a bead store; whose owner asked if I could do the job right now. I couldn't believe how fast God created the opportunity to come forth, so I accepted the job, and the **Rosary of Life** was born, which would become **The Life and Passions of Jesus Prayer** in the future. However, it took almost 6 years for the Holy Spirit to bring forth **The Life and Passions of Jesus Prayer**, through Burt Nehmer of Caridad de Porres, who asked me to write down the prayers for the Culture of Life Charity event in July of 2007. This confirmed it was time to proceed with **The Life and Passions of Jesus Prayer**; with the guidance and love of the Holy Spirit. For years I have wondered why God moved me so fast to make the Prayer Beads and The Life and Passions of Jesus Prayer, then paused. This tells me that it is never "our" time, but "God's" time, we just need to work on being patient and putting all our Trust in God.

When you pray **The Life and Passions of Jesus**; the Christian version of the Rosary using the four mysteries from the Rosary which are made up from passages in the bible for prayerful meditation and praise. As you pray 3 Mantras between each Mystery and Meditation, a Mantra is a word or phrase that you decide on or use the one listed to help draw you into a peaceful and silent place in your heart with Jesus for deeper Meditation. So as you proceed in prayer there will be 60 Mantras in your Meditation as you complete all four Mysteries of **The Life and Passions of Jesus**. Now we can say **The Life and Passions of Jesus** and pray and meditate on the entire **Life of Christ from conception to resurrection**, as one prayer of praise and Love, as we walk with Jesus. Since the approval from the Vatican on the Luminous Mysteries in 2002, we pray the Life and Passions of Jesus mysteries, starting with **Joyful** then **Luminous**, then **Sorrowful**, and then **Glorious**.

The Holy Spirit is **calling us to Pray**; to immerse ourselves in a deeper union and Love with Jesus, through the complete passions and Life of Jesus, every Saturday as a devotional for the Gift of life, and the salvation of souls. This will bring us to a deeper relationship with the **Father, Son, and Holy Spirit**, through **Faith, Hope, and Charity** as we pray the **Life and Passions of Jesus**. “Can you hear the call? **The Call to Pray**”!

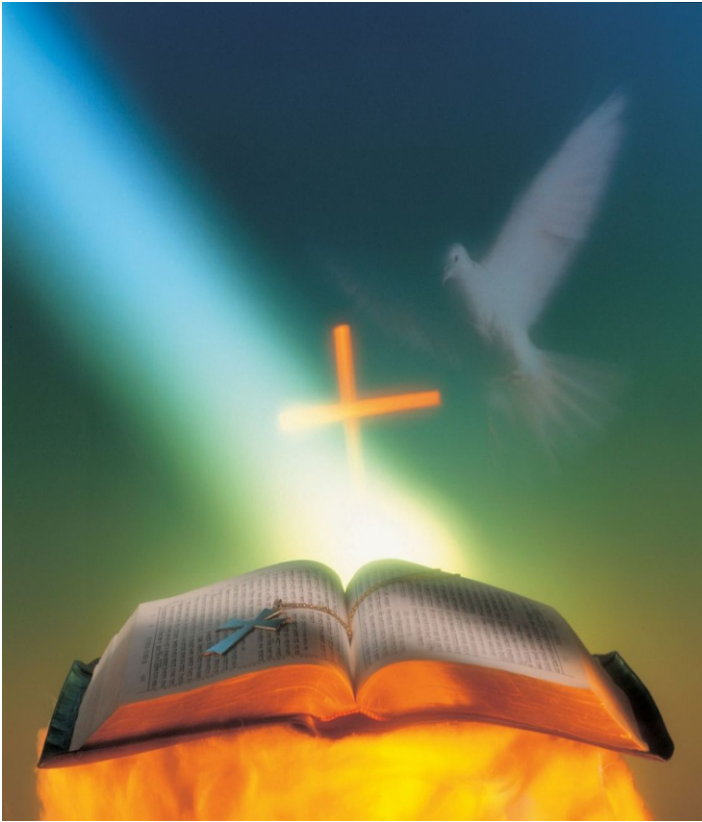
The **Life and Passions of Jesus Prayer** is not to replace the current Rosary but to enhance your prayer life. Just as the New Testament wasn't to replace the Old Testament but to enhance and fulfill the word of God, so let's pray the **Life and Passions of Jesus** as much as we can and every Saturday as a devotion to all Life, and the salvation of souls.

We need to pray for our Priests and Clergy, for an increase in faith, hope and charity, the corner stone that leads us and protects us under the blood of Christ. By praying **The Life and Passions of Jesus** we immerse ourselves in the complete passion of Christ; relying on the graces that come forth from the Holy Spirit for all our priests and souls that are always seeking to do the will of God. Then our Priest and Clergy will become the light that goes forth to call others, who in turn may go forth in the Glory of God, to call others to the light and truth that leads to the cross.

Faith leads to **Hope** and **Hope** carries us to **Charity** and the three become one, with perfect Love in Christ. The **Father, Son, and Holy Spirit** lead us from one to the other and the three become one, through the perfect gift of Love, sent through the Holy Spirit to all. Love sweet Love, how sweet that Love is; that words cannot describe. That only can be felt through perfect Love and Union with the will of God; through the graces received by the Holy Spirit. When all we do rests on God we find **Heaven on Earth!**

Personal Testimony on the making of the Life and Passions of Jesus Prayer

When I started the Rosary of Life prayer book, (now **The Day the World Changed, The Call to Pray; The Life and Passions of Jesus**) in July of 2007, I started writing down the prayers and passions as I prayed in adoration, which is praying a holy hour in front of the blessed sacrament of the living body of Christ, which is the consecration (blessing) of the bread during mass that becomes the body of Christ. Jesus Says, “For I am the living bread that came down from heaven, the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world.” Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him, says the Lord”. (John 6: 51, 56).

I met with my spiritual director Father Isaac Fynn from St. Joseph's Parish in Tucson, Arizona. He encouraged me to keep on listening to the movements of the Holy Spirit in my daily walk with Jesus as I prayed in adoration. During the process of making The Life and Passions of Jesus prayer book, Father Isaac Fynn and I met every week for spiritual guidance. The Holy Spirit communicates and guides us thru our priest, who I promised to be obedient to always.

When I was making the Prayer Beads, which is a cross with beads representing the four mysteries of the Life and Passions of Jesus, I was told in prayer to make a mini version so it could be easily carried and prayed daily. The mini version is just one mystery; you just go around 4 times to pray The Life and Passions of Jesus. The Holy Spirit, told me to give the prayer booklet and Prayer Beads to four priests. First was to Father Isaac Fynn so he could give them out to patients that were ill in the hospital. The second priest was Msgr. Thomas Cahalane, at our Mother of Sorrows in Tucson, Arizona: and I was told to ask him for permission to pray the Rosary of Life, (now the Life and Passions of Jesus Prayer) with the lady's rosary group on every Saturday as a devotion for life and the salvation of souls.

Msgr. Thomas Cahalane gave me his blessing and said if the ladies welcome you, then go ahead and pray with them. The ladies in our prayer group, love praying the Life and Passions of Jesus every Saturday. We now have been praying the devotion for over 10 years. The third priest was Father Gregory Adolf at St. Andrews in Sierra Vista, Arizona. After meeting with Father Greg Adolf, we discussed the Rosary of Life which seemed to set him back on his heels at first, as if we were trying to replace the current Rosary. So I decided to change the name from Rosary of Life to Rosary of Life Chaplet, as to not offend anyone by thinking that this was to replace the current rosary. This prayer is to help enhance our relationship and our daily walk with Jesus, to love our brothers and sisters as we love ourselves and seek the will of God in our daily lives.

The fourth priest was Father Harry Ledwith at St Pious in Tucson, Arizona. My meeting with Father Harry Ledwith went well and he received the prayer booklet and Prayer Beads with open arms. I do not know why I was told to give the life and Passions of Jesus to him. I am sure that there is a reason why The Holy Spirit, had me give the Life and Passion of Jesus to Father Harry Ledwith, and it will be revealed in God's time. Personally I may never know, but God knows, and that is all that matters. There is a 5th priest Father Joe Bracken a Jesuit Priest from Cincinnati, Ohio and a Deacon, Burt Nehmer, of Caridad De Porres in Tucson, Arizona, who was revealed to me when I was recently praying in adoration. I will be forwarding The Life and Passion of Jesus Prayer, to both of them.

Now the following is the amazing part on the power of prayer and adoration. The process to making the prayer book and prayer beads was never planned for or organized in anyway: completely done under the guidance and the quiet whisper of the Holy Spirit every day, as I prayed in adoration over the last three years. Not knowing or having any concept of where this was going or what the outcome was going to be. The prayers and Meditations came from people sharing during and after adoration. Including the people from my office where I work, Roman Catholic and non-Catholic, all different faiths contributed.

I personally could not keep up with the demand for the Prayer Beads and books. So, when I was praying I was moved by The Holy Spirit to ask if my office staff would like to stop working on their normal job duties every day and make the Prayer Beads at 3:00pm which is our Lords hour of Passion on the cross. My office staff said they would love to help. So we started making around 300 to 400 Prayer Beads a month. Each one is handmade and prayed over by the person who made it, along with a personal letter from TLC Telecom, which is signed by all of us to let them know that we care and we are praying for them. The Prayer Beads and prayer books are then given to patients at St. Joseph's hospital and the men and women going to a weekend encounter with the Cursillo movement. We will be giving it to the Vine of Grace retreat in the

My office has changed greatly and opened the hearts of many. They pray the Life and Passions of Jesus with their Families. My field technicians have also embraced the prayer and making of the Prayer Beads, sharing the prayer and Prayer Beads with friends and family in California. This one individual has come back to the faith and went to confession for the first time in nearly 20 years. There are other employees coming back to church and community. My own personal life has changed greatly; I use to do adoration once a week and now I am doing adoration every day. My joy and happiness is the grace given to me through the gift of Love, the Holy Spirit, from the Father and Son.

The name **TLC Telecom**. stands for Tender Loving Care, which was established over 10 years ago to do charitable things. By giving back to the community and to the employees to make a difference in people's lives. We have adopted the logo and mission statement of Caridad De-Porres, Feed My Sheep, (John 21:15-9) "Jesus asked a third time "Peter, do you love me" and he said to him "Lord, you know everything; you know that I love you." Jesus said to him "Feed my sheep". Jesus calls all of us and asks, "**Do you love me?**" Through our love for Jesus we are all called to care for, provide for, and love our brother and sisters. Even when things get difficult or seem like we are not making a difference, to persevere, even if it is to help just one person. Amen."

Caridad is Spanish for charity; we as a corporation believe that it is the small acts of charity done in everyday life that makes a difference. We want to challenge other corporations to do small acts of charity and give back to their community and the employees. All we need to do is take action, and respond to the call of love and charity which is in our daily walk with Jesus. Every "yes" we give to God, transforms the world.

I also believe that our corporation started transforming 3 years ago, when the corporation decided to hand out the prayer booklets the Magnificat, which is a daily reading with the word of God, to all the employees that wanted to respond to the word of God, that is for all. So this planted a seed, the word of God, which grew in all of us as we started our walk with Jesus. Now we share on the word of God, pray and make the prayer booklets and rosary/chaplets every day at our office. "All things are possible with God."

Things have moved so fast, my spiritual director Father Isaac Fynn wanted us to meet with our Bishop of Tucson, Arizona, Bishop Kicanas and get his blessing. We met and gave Bishop Kicanas the prayer book and Rosary Chaplet for prayerful consideration. After discussing the name of the Rosary of Life Chaplet with him, Bishop Kicanas had the same exact comments and concerns for the name Rosary of Life as Father Greg Adolf of Sierra Vista, Arizona. It became evident to me that The Holy Spirit wanted me to spend more time praying in adoration. I really thought I was done with the prayer book; did you notice the word I? My mistake!

Thinking I could do this and complete the prayer booklet without praying to The Holy Spirit on the name of the prayer book for The Gift of Life and the Salvation of Souls! The name of the book is the only thing that had not been done in prayer and adoration. So we will be forwarding the new prayer book to our Bishop, Priests and one Deacon, once The Holy Spirit reveals the name to me and helps me to complete the meditations and prayers for the devotion. So I went to our Mother of Sorrows Church for adoration and prayer, asking The Holy Spirit to help me with the name as to not offend anyone and let me know what to name the Prayers and Devotion to Jesus! When I was praying the following scripture Acts 11:1-18 was put in my heart; just as Peter received in a dream that the Holy Spirit was not only for the chosen people of God, but for the gentiles, all people, The Holy Spirit revealed to me the name of the prayer and devotion to be **The Life and Passions of Jesus Prayer**, and the book, **The Call to Pray** came later on 01/01/09. This prayer and meditation on **The Life and Passion of Jesus**, are for all people who want to walk with Jesus. The Holy Spirit calls all of us to **Pray, Pray, Pray**, **“Prayer will change the world”**. God wants all of us to pray, **The Life Passions of Jesus**, and take them into our lives, to walk with Jesus and be led by the Holy Spirit for the Glory of God, Amen.

If you are wondering why we are doing this at **TLC Telecom** or what we are looking to get out of this; the answer would be “nothing” just a chance to give back to others what we have received freely! Our gift from God is grace, joy and the gift of love. We hope to give **The Life and Passions of Jesus** to whoever wants to pray and walk with Jesus daily. Then of course, whomever The Holy Spirit tells us to give it to as well. Let me share one last thing with you; that can only come from God, The Gift of Silence.

We are called to **Pray, Pray, Pray!** In the name of Jesus, “Amen” (John 14: 4,6,14 cf)



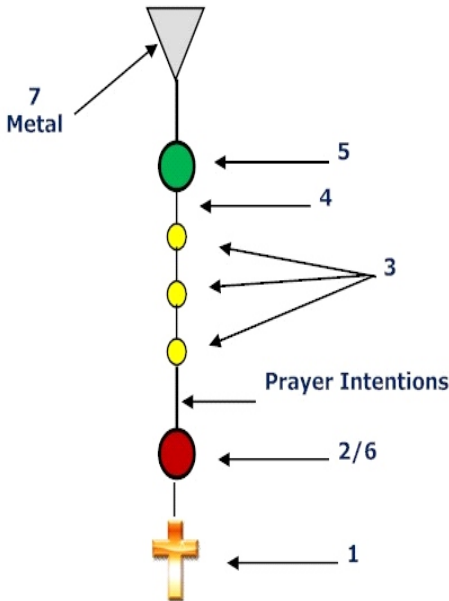

(Prayer Beads are optional)

Holy Spirit Prayer Beads



1. Prayer/in the Name of Jesus.
2. Our Father Prayer
3. Mantra Prayer- Pray on each of the three beads.
4. Oh My Jesus Prayer.
5. Announce the Start of the Five Joyful Mysteries, Then, an Our Father Prayer, and then Announce the First Joyful Mystery then Proceed to #3, the three Mantras
6. Announce the 2nd Mystery, continue on to complete Joyful Mysteries. Go back and forth on Bead 5, and 6 for Luminous, Sorrowful, and Glorious Mysteries, complete the same as you did the Joyful.
7. Pray on the metal. When You finish all four Mysteries, Spiritual Armor, Prayer /In The Name of (See Below)

When you have completed the Joyful Mysteries you continue with the five Luminous Mysteries the same way as you did the Joyful Mysteries, go back and forth between beads #5, and 6 and then continue in the same manner with the Sorrowful and Glorious Mysteries. Finish on #7 with The Spiritual Armor Prayer / Personal Prayer / We pray, in the name of Jesus.

Life and Passions of Jesus Prayer is done with 3 Mantras per mystery with 1 Our Father prayer at the Beginning of the mysteries and (1) O my Jesus prayer at the end of the mysteries. You can order the holy spirit prayer beads on the website, or make your own. When you pray the prayers and meditations, you will see how easy it is to pray the Life and Passions of Jesus Prayer.

*See attached prayers with Meditations and all four Mysteries on the next pages. You can use the Mantra listed or use your own personal Mantra. Mantra is a word or phrase that helps you quiet your mind so you can go into a deeper meditation.

Prayers to be used with the Mysteries and Meditations

All four mysteries have a scripture as a reference, they are not always word for word and there are additional passages quoted but not always Referenced for deeper thought and Meditation. You don't need Prayer Beads to pray, all prayers are listed, just read and meditate in prayer. This prayer is not to replace the rosary; it is just another form of prayer, the Christian version of the Rosary.

For personal prayer or group prayer: The announcer says the mystery and the part not in green for the prayers. The group says the part marked in green, for meditation and prayers. For individuals, pray all mysteries, meditations and prayers silently to yourself. **When praying each mantra in private prayer, not group prayer, close your eyes and when you complete each mantra breathe in through your nose and then exhale, repeat for each mantra, for deeper meditation to quiet and center one's self to be one with God.**

In the Name of Prayer: (John 14:4,6,14) (Pray one time at the beginning)

“We pray, In the name of Jesus. Amen.” (Eyes Closed, Breath in 3 times, receive the Holy Spirit)

Our Father Prayer (Pray one time now and at the start of Mysteries)

OUR FATHER, Who art in Heaven, hallowed be Thy Name. Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in Heaven. **Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.**

(Announce) **Presentation of Jesus in the Temple** / Luke 2: 22-38: Mary and Joseph go up to the temple, as proscribed by law, “for every 1st born male shall be consecrated to the Lord.” When they saw the child, **Simeon and Anna rejoiced at the sight of the coming Savior of the World**
(Mantra – Close Your Eyes, Pray 1 or 3 times)

(Announce) **Finding of the child Jesus in the Temple** / Luke 2: 41-52: Mary and Joseph cannot find Jesus and look with great worry and anxiety. Upon finding Jesus in the temple, he says, **“Did you not know I must be in my Father's house?”**
(Mantra – Close Your Eyes, Pray 1 or 3 times)

**Close with O my Jesus – Prayer)
(Add your own mantra)**

(Mantra - Pray 1 or 3 times)

(Announce) Scourged at the Pillar / Mark 15: 15: Jesus is whipped and scourged at the pillar for all of our sins, **so that we may be reconciled to Him, for He loves us so much**

(Mantra - Pray 1 or 3 times)

(Announce) Crowning of Thorns / Mark 15:16-20: Jesus is mocked, spat on and then crowned as King of the Jews, **“For the Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom, for many.”**

31. (Breathe in) **Piety** (Exhale) **or** (breathe in half the word and then exhale the rest)
32. (Breathe in) **Wisdom** (Exhale) **or** (breathe in half the word and then exhale the rest)
33. **Use your own mantra, word or phrase that makes your heart sing.** You don't have to breathe in and exhale a mantra. You can just say the mantra as a group or silently to yourself.

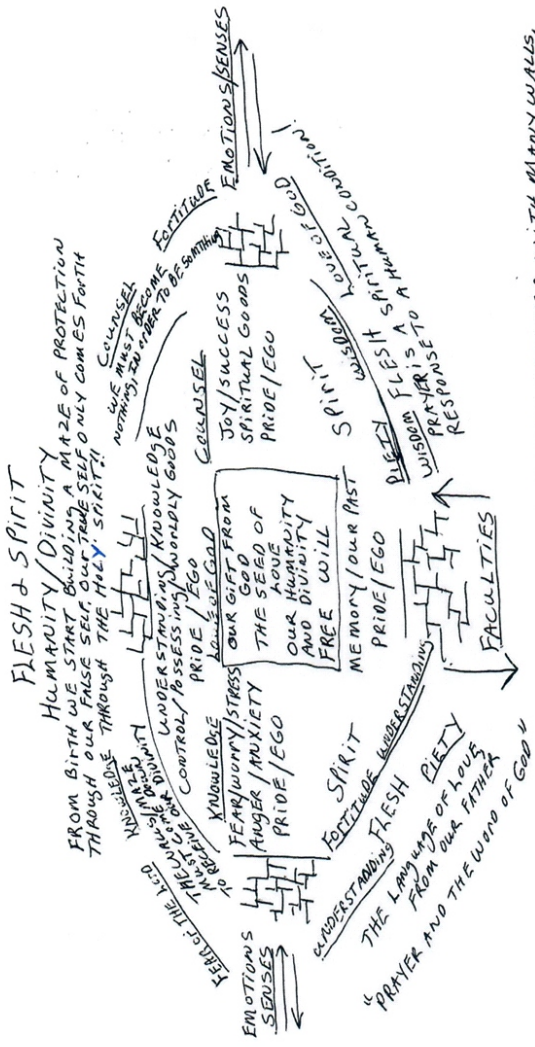
“Martyrdom of the heart and flesh”

(Close your eyes) “**for the love of Jesus,**” “**and the salvation of souls.**” (3 times, or more if needed)
(Breathe in) (Exhale)

(**Apostles of Prayer/consecration**) I **love** you Jesus with all my heart, I offer all my prayers for the salvation of souls, the conversion of hearts, the gift of life and the right for life, for all people who have no one to pray for them. For our priest and vocations to the priesthood. To my beloved Jesus, I offer all I am and all I will be for your Glory; your **Love**; may your will always be done Lord, not mine. May my heart always be yours; to be a servant to all, along with all the graces and gifts you give me; may I give them freely to others. Help me to pray every day, for you are the source of prayer, may my soul always proclaim the greatness of the Lord; though **Faith, Hope, and Love**. Grant me the **Love, Protection, and Guidance** of the **Holy Spirit** as we serve and **Love our brothers and sisters as Apostles of Prayer; “In the name of Jesus, Amen”**

(Close your eyes, Breathing in) “**for the love of Jesus,**” (exhaling) “**and the salvation of souls.**” (Three times)

Have Mercy on me, **God**, in your goodness; In your abundant compassion blot out my offense. O wash me more and more from my guilt and cleanse me from my sin. My offenses truly I know them; my sin is always before me. Against you, you alone, have I sinned; what is evil in your sight I have done. Indeed, you love truth in the heart; then in the secret of my heart teach me wisdom. O purify me, then I shall be clean; O wash me, I shall be whiter than snow. From my sins turn always your face and blot out all my guilt. A pure heart create for me, **O God**, put a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me away from your presence, nor deprive me of your **Holy Spirit**. Give me again the joy of your help; with a spirit of fervor to sustain me that I may teach transgressors your ways and sinners may return to you. O rescue me, **God**, my helper, and my tongue shall ring out your goodness. **Father, open my lips and my mouth shall declare your praise, do not spurn a broken and humbled heart.** (PS:51,1-17 cf) In my silence I find the living and beating **heart of Jesus**. May **God** look upon me today as I pray and see his beloved Son in me, and be pleased to grant me the keys to the kingdom of Heaven today, so that I may go out today and return **love for love**; through the out-pouring of the **Holy Spirit** to transform me; so that I may be one with the Divine Will of **God**, as I cry out,

Preface/Praying with the Holy Spirit

This is a brief introduction to the Holy God Prayer. Prayer is your own individual relationship with God. So pray every day for God to lead the way in your daily life; through the love of Jesus and the Gifts of the **Holy Spirit**. Pray your own personal prayers, or pray the **Holy God Prayer**, but most of all pray! For prayer is like water to a plant, we must pray in order to grow and receive our full inheritance as children of God! So pray daily and invite the **Holy Spirit** into your life; by praying the **Holy God Prayer** each day, which is made up of three prayers listed below. The **Holy Spirit Prayer**, **The Holy Jesus Prayer** and the **Holy Trinity Prayer**. Taking up your cross and walk with **Jesus on the way of the cross**, so you can go out every day to witness with **love** as apostles of Prayer, for the salvation of souls. These 3 prayers that make up the **Holy God Prayer** in this book, have been poured into my heart through the Holy Spirit, from God our Father. That I have been told to share with all people. For we must learn to receive love in order to give love! “For what we have received freely we are to give freely, **Love**.”

Holy Spirit Prayer

To receive our inheritance as children of God! The Gifts of the Holy Spirit; that lead us, protect us and calls us to serve others. To give freely to others what God has given to us. **“Love”**. For the Salvation of Souls and the Glory of the Kingdom of God, **“for if we ask we shall receive.”**

Holy Jesus Prayer/Receiving the Gifts of the Holy Beatitudes

The beatitudes are a gift from God, the 8 spiritual commandments of love. which calls us and tells us how we need to **Be** in our daily lives, with the **attitude of Love; Be-attitude**. That will lead us to the truth and comfort us with the Gifts of the Holy Spirit on our daily journey; as we seek Christ in all things and all people; to put on **“Love”**, that is, the bond of perfection (Col 3-14) The Beatitudes will also help prepare us to carry our daily cross, as we walk with
Jesus on **The Way of the Cross**.

Holy Trinity Prayer/The Way of the Cross/ Receiving the Gift of Love

Walking with Jesus everyday on The Way of the Cross, helps you empty yourself; so that “It is no longer “I” who live; but Christ who lives in me,” for the Life I now live in the flesh, I live by Faith in the son of God; who has loved me so much, he gave himself to be crucified and die on a cross for me; so I may be one with him. May I carry my cross each day with Christ; to love my brothers and sisters as I love myself, and give freely to others what Christ has given to me. **“Love”!!!**

Holy God Prayer

Praying all three prayers above as one continuous prayer. Breathing in the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Listening to Jesus on the Sermon on the Mount. Walking with Jesus on the way of the cross to awaken anew every day.

You can pray one or two of the prayers listed above, start with the opening prayers and finish with the closing prayers. So in reality you have a choice of seven different prayers every day. To be transformed and made anew every day.



How it Came to Be *The Holy Spirit Prayers/The Way of the Cross*

All three prayers have been done over the last fourteen years. These prayers came to me through the **Holy Spirit** during my daily meditation and prayer time throughout the years. My hope is to pass on what my **father** has put in my heart to share with all; the power of **prayer** and the **word of God**.

There are several forms of prayer that are captured in these prayers. Silent prayer, vocal prayer/group prayer, scriptural prayer, mental prayer, centering prayer, and contemplative **Holy Spirit** prayer. **Prayer and meditation are a spiritual response to a human condition!**

Our goal is to always grow in our faith and our prayer life. We need to incorporate all of our faculties and senses that come forth from our humanity, and of the world, and merge our flesh with the spirit for balance and harmony; to be one with God. Jesus tells us we must die to self and be reborn, we must decrease and the **Holy Spirit** must increase. For this can only be done through the grace and love that come's forth from our Heavenly Father. Our Father promises, if we ask we shall receive the Gifts of the **Holy Spirit**, as we walk with Jesus on our daily journey.

We need to understand how to marry our physical and spiritual selves together. Most people only live one dimension of their lives, which is the physical. We need to be awakened to our spiritual being, for we all are children of God; we are human and divine. So let's ask our **father** every day for the gift of love, the **Holy Spirit** which will be poured into our hearts every day if we ask. Remember we will always receive the **Holy Spirit** in the measure we are open to receive the **Holy Spirit**.

There will be many times our pride and ego will get in the way, keeping us from receiving the gifts of the **Holy Spirit**, that our **father** has for us each and every day. That is why we need to live one day at a time. For **Jesus** tells us there is enough worry for today; let tomorrow worry about tomorrow. Live today, and love today, for that is all we really have.

There are many forms of Prayer and all prayer is good. The more we pray and meditate the more we will grow in our faith and love for others. Now we need to open our mind and heart to practice the different forms of prayer and meditation. Learning how to breathe, when breathing in the gifts of the **Holy Spirit**. For myself, I like to breathe in through my nose and exhale through the nose; with my eyes closed. This brings me into a place of peace and quiet; it helps quite the mind which in many cases can become our worst enemy, when trying to listening to the **Holy Spirit** through our prayers and the **word of God**.

These three prayers that come to you by the **Holy Spirit** are for our daily journey. As we walk with Jesus he will transform our lives, if we do them on a daily basis. Why? Because if you ask your father for something so good, and what he has promised all his children throughout history, would he not give you all this and more. **For I am just a messenger called to spread the word of God and The call to pray!** So if you cannot believe or understand, then take the challenge to **pray and meditate for 40 days and listen to the Holy Spirit**. For I was promised by my heavenly Father that all who ask for the **Holy Spirit** and take up the cross of love every day, will be transformed from one glory to the next and receive their full inheritance as children of God! Your Father has many gifts to give you on your journey through life, as a child of God; receiving your divinity. Should we not go every day to the greatest source and teacher of love and truth; ask and we shall receive the **Holy Spirit!**

Holy Spirit Prayer

This prayer came to be during a prayer session on January 1st, 2009. There was a voice inside of me that called out; "I am the voice of one crying out in the desert, make straight the way of the Lord." (John 1:23) So the prayer of the **Holy Spirit** came to be.

This prayer is a very simple prayer. It is based on the seven gifts of the **Holy Spirit** and breathing in each gift of the Spirit after each mantra. Using a mantra is a word or phrase used to draw you into a deeper meditative prayer by quieting our faculties and senses, by using breathing techniques and closing your eyes. This will draw you more into mental prayer, centering prayer, and contemplative **Holy Spirit** prayer.

Holy Jesus Prayer/Receiving the Gifts of the Holy Beatitudes

This prayer came to be January 1st, 2010. The **beatitudes** are a spiritual gift from our father through his beloved son, Jesus. In the Old Testament we have the 10 commandments of the law that were given for our flesh and how to live in this world. The **beatitudes** are our 8 spiritual commandments of love, so we can live by the law of the Spirit of love. The beatitudes are our spiritual essence, that is to be woven into our flesh, so that we become one with our heavenly father, as children of God! Blessed is the righteous man, for he is a law unto himself; for the fruit of the spirit is **love** and for such there is no law!

Holy Trinity Prayer/The Way of the Cross/Receiving the Gift of Love

This prayer came to be after the 911 terrorist attacks in 2001. Taking up the cross of love everyday with Jesus and walking with Jesus every day. This prayer has changed over the many years, it now has a mantra, the Gifts of the Holy Spirit, after each meditation. These prayers are very interactive, so we can dialog back and forth with Jesus as we prepare to go out into the world every day. **To live and love our faith and share it with others, by giving to others what has been given to us, "Love"**.

Holy Trinity Prayer, is made up with **14 passions of the cross** and one closing prayer at the end, which is based on the spiritual armor prayer from Ephesians 6:11-17. The **Passions of the Cross** have a prayerful reflection or a scriptural reference to go with each passion. When you finish each passion, you breathe in the gift of the **Holy Spirit** within yourself and then proceed to the **Forsake of Prayer**; to draw you into walking and receiving the Holy Spirit with Jesus every day.

This prayer has the same two prayers that go with **each passion of the cross**. The **Eternal Father Prayer**, of praise, love and gratitude for the atonement of all of our sins and those of the whole world. When praying the **Forsake of Prayer** after each passion, close your eyes and breathe in the Gift of the Spirit, after each prayer. To quiet and center yourself as you walk with Jesus. This is a very powerful prayer to help us realize that we can do nothing without our **heavenly father**, if we wish to seek the kingdom of God. So we may return, love for love, as children of God. All the gifts we receive from our father on a daily base are to be returned and given to others. For we are only doing what we should be doing as children of God every day. So don't expect any special praises from others; our reward is, when we have fought the good fight, kept the faith, shared our faith, returned love for love. Then we shall finish the race and return home to our **heavenly father**.

This is our opportunity in the physical and spiritual realm of things to begin our journey home here on earth. So we may have a small taste of heaven on earth, as we begin our purification process in our physical body; becoming one with our spiritual being. For we are all human and divine as children of God!

The Call to Pray

This is a brief introduction to the prayer book The Sacred Heart of Jesus, order of Apostles of Prayer for the Laity. For all the common, ordinary people, the Laity who form the body of the church in our Community. For those who feel called to deeper prayer and contemplative prayer; you will become **prayer warriors** for The Sacred Heart of Jesus; who sends forth the Gifts of the Holy Spirit

Let us put on our spiritual armor, as **prayer warriors**. Put on the Armor of God, stand firm in the truth, and let righteousness be your breast plate, hold faith as your shield from God, to quench all the flaming arrows of the evil one; with the helmet of salvation from his beloved Son; Jesus, and the mighty sword; the word of God that is revealed through the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Let the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit be a light to your feet as you walk in the world on the path of righteousness; to love and help lead others to the Kingdom of God.

Let's go out today and battle the things of the flesh, as you walk in the spirit to seek and do the will of God. Live and walk in your faith and others will follow. Prayer is the spiritual backbone of the church, **Pray, Pray, Pray, for Prayer will change the world.**

The **Apostles of Prayer** is an answer to “The Call to Pray”, giving the laity the opportunity to embrace the word of God through **study, piety**, and putting **action** to their faith on a daily basis. The laity are like lost sheep, wanting to respond to “The Call to Pray”. People will always respond and embrace some kind of structure that helps them clearly know what they must do in order to ground themselves in the word of God and prayer. So like red hot coals in a fire, that put forth the greatest amount of heat, then fire comes forth; in the same fashion we ground ourselves in the word of God and prayer, we fortify and sanctify ourselves in the body and blood of Christ. We become those red hot coals, we catch on fire, with the flames of the Holy Spirit, to go forth in our daily lives, loving our brothers and sisters and sharing the **Gift of Love** for the salvation of souls.

When you take the vow to embrace “The Call to Pray”, grounding yourself in prayer and the study of the word of God daily. God will truly transform your life putting action to your faith, for God truly is calling us to be prayer warriors. To go out as **Apostles of Prayer** for the salvation of souls; to embrace the gifts of life, to help lead others to eternal life in the Kingdom of God, with the **Father, Son, and Holy Spirit**.

The foundation of the **Apostle of Prayer** is sacrifice, prayer and the living word of God; reading the daily scriptures, meditating and praying on them to go out and live our faith in all of our daily duties.

Apostles of Prayer has been set up to help you grow in your love and devotion for Jesus, Our Savior, calling us to immerse ourselves in his Life and Passions through the word of God, as you pray the prayer of the Holy Spirit and the 14 Passions of the Cross daily. Praying The Life and Passions of Jesus from conception to resurrection, every Saturday as devotion for the **Gift of Life** and the **salvation of souls**.

This apostolate of prayer was not set up to add additional burden to anyone's already busy daily schedule. All that is required is your love for Jesus, our Savior, and your “yes” to the gifts of the Holy Spirit; with a deep desire to pray and give back to others what you have received freely from God!

In order not to be unfaithful to the grace of the apostolate, three cautions are particularly necessary. First of all, one must always seek and take great care for humility, defending oneself against the flattering voices of praise and success. If Lucifer, an Angel of God fell from heaven, it

will be easy to believe an apostle too is subject to such a fall; being man and weighed down by sin and temptation. The second thing required would be constant vigilance which is necessary, to maintain intimate contact with God, for just as iron becomes red hot and glows only when it is in contact with fire, so the apostle radiates the divine light and warmth only if he keeps himself united to God who is their only source.

Lastly, it is of the greatest importance to persevere in perfect detachment from one's own will and judgment. In regard to this, St. John of the Cross warns us that among the many wiles used by the devil to deceive spiritual persons, the most ordinary is that of deceiving them under an appearance of what is good, not under an appearance of what is evil : for he knows that if they recognize evil, they will scarcely touch it”.

Therefore, in order not to fall into his snare, Saint John of the Cross warns us never to undertake any action “however good and full of charity” it may seem to be, without the sanction of obedience and guidance of our spiritual director. This advice is good not only for religious but for all who work in the apostolate, because all should be submissive to the body of Christ our church and it's authority.



The **Apostles of prayer** is calling you to pray every morning, to pray one of **The Holy Spirit Prayers** and **The Way of the Cross** and to pray the mantra: “**for the love of Jesus and the salvation of souls**” during the day when the world comes crashing in, to ask our heavenly father for help! I can promise one thing, if you take on this vow of obedience to pray and serve others, God will surely transform your Life! We are all called to be apostles, for we all are different and we all have our own special gifts. God made us and Love’s us. Remember you are perfect today and exactly where God wants you today; when you are seeking and walking today in the will of God to Love your brothers and your sisters and to give freely to others what God has given to you through **grace**, the gift of **Love** for the Salvation of souls.

So let me warn you about some of the traps of the evil one, “**The Devil**”. When you miss a prayer time, don’t punish yourself; just acknowledge to God that you need his help when things get very busy during the day. It is hard sometimes to stop at 3:00pm “The hour of passion for Jesus” or if you miss your morning or evening prayer or if you don’t have time; due to your work schedule on any given day, just pray to your self, “I Love you Jesus and I offer all I do today for the salvation of souls.”

There is no doubt you will miss times to pray in fact, there has not been one week that I personally have completed all prayer times, I either missed the time, couldn’t complete due to distractions or I fell asleep. The key is to never get discouraged or give up, let this be a reminder; our flesh is weak, and we can do nothing without God, for all things are possible with God. Seek humility and service, for Jesus calls us to be a servant to all! **So always remember just your love, desire, and intentions to pray is a beautiful prayer in itself; that ascends to heaven for love and Glory of God and the salvation of souls. For we are of the flesh and not perfect; but our hearts can be perfect with the Love and Desire to praise and Love God and all our brothers and sisters in service and prayer.** God knows your intentions and your heart so don’t let the “devil” use **Guilt** to stop you from praying. Remember, your faith belongs to you, it is a gift from God and nobody can take your faith, so rejoice and **always rely on God!**

The next one would be **Envy** the devil loves this one. Wanting what someone else has or comparing your spirituality with someone else’s spirituality, remember we are all different but we all have our own gifts, embrace what God has given you, and always remember you are exactly where God wants you today, so go out and **love and serve God today.**

The next would be **Pride**; you must always be on watch; for pride can go undetected. Make sure you are praying every day, reading and meditating on the word of God. Pray every day for a heart of love and service, seek humility, obedience to God, and for Gods will to be done in your daily life today as you go out into the world to **work and serve God.**

Christian prayer is to be uniquely bold and courageous! It is to be persistent in the face of what may seem like God’s lack of response. We are never to lose heart, but be ever-confident and trusting that the Father hears and answers all who come to him. And he grants the extraordinary gifts and the help of the Holy Spirit, to those who ask him. Make sure you put on your spiritual armor and pray for God’s divine assistance every day, to seek his beloved Son Jesus, that you may see Jesus; in all things and all people today. Give freely to others what God has given to you!



Saint Theresa says it well when she encourages us; **Let nothing disturb you. Let nothing frighten you, all things pass away, God never changes, patience obtains all things; he who has God finds he lacks nothing; God alone suffices.**

We must not believe that because we have taken a vow of obedience to the apostolate or dedicated ourselves to religious works makes us better than anyone. “Give to God what is God’s” If the coin which bears the image of Caesar should be restored to Caesar, with much greater reason should our soul, which bears the image of God, be restored to God. To say that we must give our soul to God is to say that we owe him everything. To fulfill our duties toward our neighbor, toward our equals or our inferiors, is to fulfill our duty toward God; it is to restore to Him everything He has given us, by submitting our freedom to His law, by putting our will in the service of His will. It should make you realize your nothingness, that God has granted you grace and the gift of love to serve and to give freely to others. You are called to be a servant to all! Remember love never takes; it always gives so if you are taking, it is not love. **Love, is perfect; NEVER FAILS.**

There is no wrong way to pray if it is from your heart, for love is perfect, it bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, and endures all things. (1-Corinthians 13:7-8) Brothers and sisters: if you are guided by the spirit; you are not under the law; the fruit of spirit is Love; against such there is no law. Now those who belong to Jesus Christ have crucified their flesh with its passions and desire.

Let us plant seeds and water them with prayers, God will make them grow. To enter the Sacred Heart of Jesus order of **Apostles of Prayer** all that is required is to take a vow of obedience to the sacred heart of Jesus. Pray every morning the prayer of the Holy Spirit or say the prayer of the beatitudes and take up your cross and walk with Jesus, when praying The Way of the Cross. By doing the vow of consecration; giving of yourself freely, for the Love of God and the salvation of souls; God is rejoicing in heaven, because you are giving of your own free will; an act of true love. God has Grace upon Grace to give you, so embrace the gifts you receive from him and give freely to others what God has given to you. Remember God wants to give you so much; but He only can give you what you can receive at that moment, so allow God to increase and you to decrease as you walk on your journey of faith with Jesus Christ Our Savior. Be patient and God will transform your Life, for all things are possible with God.

“Our hours of adoration will be special hours of reparation for sins, and intercession for the needs of the whole world, exposing the sin-sick and suffering humanity to the healing, sustaining and transforming rays of Jesus, radiating from the Eucharist.”

“Our holy hour is our daily family prayer where we get together and pray the Rosary before the exposed Blessed Sacrament the first half hour, and the second half hour we pray in silence.” When people asked Mother Teresa how many convents she has she responded, “We have 584 tabernacles.” “When you look at the crucifix, you understand how much Jesus loved you. When you look at the Scared Host you understand how much Jesus loves you now. This is why you should ask your parish priest to have Perpetual Adoration in your parish. I beg the Blessed Mother to touch the hearts of all parish priests that they may have Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration in their parishes, and that it may spread throughout the entire world.” The time you spend with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament is the best time you will spend on earth. Each moment that you spend with Jesus will deepen your union with Him and make your soul everlastingly more glorious and beautiful in Heaven, and will help bring about everlasting peace on earth.”

“O God, we believe You are here. We adore You and love You with our whole heart and soul because You are most worthy of all our love. We desire to love You as the Blessed do in Heaven...Flood our souls with Your spirit and life. Penetrate and possess our whole being utterly, that our lives may only be a radiance of Yours. The Glory of Faith

“Faith is the confident assurance concerning what we hope for, and conviction about things we do not see” (Heb 11:1)

A true Christian is one who believes that Jesus is alive today in the Blessed Sacrament – Living, dwelling. Loving and calling us to Himself. (“Eternal life is this: to know You, the only true God, and Him whom You have sent, Jesus Christ.”)

In His Eucharistic discourse, Jesus was asked:

“What must we do to perform the works of God?” Jesus replied:

“This is the work of God: HAVE FAITH IN THE ONE WHOM HE SENT.”

If He were visible, everybody would want to be with Him, but Jesus hides His glory and beauty in the Blessed Sacrament because He wants us to come to Him in faith, THAT WAY WE MAY LOVE HIM FOR HIMSELF.

If our faith in the Eucharist (communion) is weak, then we simply pray:

“Lord, I do believe, help my unbelief.”

For the gift of faith, all we have to do is ask:

“Ask and you shall receive, seek and you shall find, knock and it shall be opened.”

The Glory of Hope

“They that hope in the Lord will renew their strength; they will soar as with eagles' wings.” (Is 40:31)

“All things were created through Him and for Him.”

Peace is the happiness and total fulfillment we find in God. *“My peace is my gift to you. I do not give it as the world gives.”* Our hope for happiness is centered not on the possessions of things, but on the possession of God alone.

“You are my God. My happiness lies in You alone.”

Hope is the light that centers all our attentions and desires. On the possession of God for all eternity, 'For our hearts were made for God and they are restless until they rest in Him.'

“In God alone is my soul at rest, for my hope comes from Him.”

“Hope will never leave us disappointed”, for Jesus is infinitely more interested in seeking us than we are of seeking Him. *“I am certain that nothing will be able to separate us from the love of God, made visible in Christ Jesus Our Lord.”* God is good beyond all description!

‘To fall in love with God is the greatest of all romances; to seek Him, the greatest adventure; to find Him, the greatest human achievement.’ “God is love” Who “loved us first” and who takes a thousand steps toward us for our one step toward him.

“I am sure of this much: that He who has begun the good work in you will carry it through to completion.”

The Glory of Charity/Love and Renewal

“I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing.” (Lk 12:49)

The apostles were gathered around Mary in prayer as we are today, when the Holy Spirit descended upon them as tongues of fire; that same fire of divine love that inflames the Heart of Jesus in the Eucharist, where the very *“love of God is poured into our hearts.”* The Holy Eucharist is the 'new and everlasting covenant', the 'sacrament of unity', the 'bond of love' between God and man. ***“Perfect love casts out all fear.”***

His Eucharistic Heart is THE SOURCE OF ALL LOVE.

The Church is the Bride of Christ who nourishes us and renews us unceasingly in this Holy Eucharist by renewing His Spirit within us and giving us a new heart: *“I shall give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you.”* He exchanges our 'stony hearts' with His very own 'Heart of flesh', that we may 'love God in all things and above all things'. Through His Eucharistic love, Jesus transforms us into Himself. ***“It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me.”*** Jesus revealed His Heart as an “infinite ocean' of mercy and love. Here we drink in the living waters of His Holy Spirit. Jesus cries out: ***“If any man thirsts let him come to Me.”***

We are called to Pray, Pray, Pray! In the name of Jesus, “Amen”
